

GCTS MOBILE APPS PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you access our mobile applications (the "Applications"). Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. You will be deemed to have been made aware of, will be subject to, and will be deemed to have accepted the changes in any revised Privacy Policy by your continued use of the Application after the date such revised Privacy Policy is posted.

COLLECTION OF YOUR INFORMATION

We may collect information about you in a variety of ways. The information we may collect via our Applications depends on the content and materials you use, and includes:

Personal Data
